

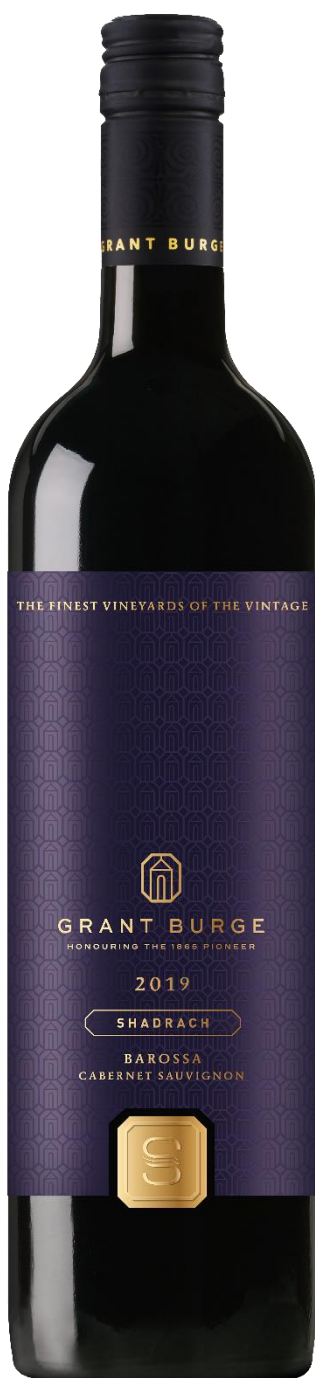


GRANT BURGE

HONOURING THE 1865 PIONEER

The story of Grant Burge is one of the past, the present, and the future. Planting their roots in the Barossa Valley in 1865, the Burges began as a family of devoted vignerons. For five generations, they spent their days toiling on the land, understanding the soil, and from it, growing grapes that would become premium wines of today.

2019 Shadrach Cabernet Sauvignon



The 2019 Shadrach speaks to the Eden Valley region of Barossa Cabernet Sauvignon potential in a warm dry year. With varietal aromas and flavours across the palate, it is a complex and expressive wine that will reward for many years.

GRAPE VARIETY

Cabernet Sauvignon

COLOUR

Deep red crimson with purple rim.

NOSE

Lifted leafy cassis, hints of freshly roasted coffee and spearmint.

PALATE

Flavors reminiscent of milk chocolate coated coffee beans, backed by subtle notes of eucalypt. Elegant sweet red berry fruit, with fine focused tannin giving the wine a persistence.

VINEYARD REGION

Barossa Valley

The 2019 vintage was one of the driest we have experienced. Below average winter rainfall, coupled with a dry spring and summer resulted in naturally lower yields across the vineyards. These climatic conditions resulted in rich and concentrated wines, although low in quantity.

WINE ANALYSIS

Alc/Vol: 14.4%

Acidity (TA): 6.19 g/L

pH: 3.35

Residual Sugar: <0.3 g/L

PEAK DRINKING

Drink on release or enjoy with careful cellaring between 5-15 years of age.

Chateaubriand with red wine jus and roasted vegetables.
