# GRAPE VARIETY

Shiraz

#### COLOUR

Dense deep purple, with electric bright purple hues.

#### NOSE

Incredibly enticing with dark cherry, blackcurrant and olive, Intertwined with hints of blueberry and sweet dark chocolate.

### PALATE

This year's Miamba Shiraz may well be one of the best and most generously flavoured wines produced under the Miamba label. A generous, sweet red fruit palate with lashings of sweet dark chocolate and mocha. Fine, Integrated tannins with a long, lingering finish.

#### VINTAGE CONDITIONS

One of the most exceptional vintages on record. With excellent winter rains, near average rainfall and a full moisture profile in the soil, the vines flourished throughout the season. This is an exceptional vintage, producing balanced wines with great fruit intensity and concentration.
