GRAPE VARIETY

Pinot Gris

COLOUR

Clear pale straw.

NOSE

White flowers, lychee and freshly cut pear with some sweet musk flavours

PALATE

Bright and crisp acid, but with generous mouthfeel to balance. The wine has a pithy texture with flavours of nashi pear, lychee and rosewater

VINEYARD REGION

Adelaide Hills

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

Cool vintage with high incidence of rainfall made for a delayed growing season with good acid retention

WINE ANALYSIS

Residual Sugar: 3.4 g/L

PEAK DRINKING

Drink now. Up to 3 years
