GRAPE VARIETY

Riesling

COLOUR

Pale yellow with slight green hues

NOSE

The bouquet is full of citrus peel, jasmine florals and lemon blossom. There are hints of white peach and grapefruit intertwined with a minerality.

PALATE

The wine has fresh citrus up front with cherry blossom and green apple on the mid palate. This wine has vibrant acidity which gives it excellent persistence.

VINEYARD REGION

Eden Valley

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

This wine is made from a blend of the best parcel out of the Eden valley. 2021 vintage saw below average rainfall and mild temperature. During Spring and Summer night temperatures were below average leading to significant diurnal shifts allowing for beautiful grape ripening and quality.
